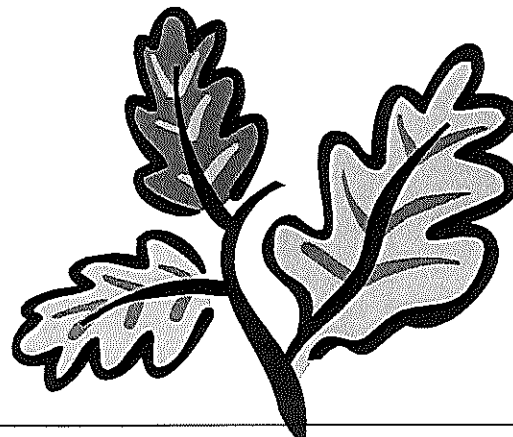
Business Licenses for 2012 expire on December 31, 2012 and 2013 Business Licenses will be on sale in December. If you should have one and don't, please get to the Town Office as soon as possible with your application. 2012 vehicle decals need to be displayed on your vehicles now in order to avoid a fine. You will need your current vehicle registration and your personal property taxes must be current. Personal Property and Real Estate Taxes are due December 5th. The Town has extended the contract with Waste Management to continue with the waste disposal for the residential garbage in Town. The contract allows each residence one of the Waste Management curbside containers. Please refrain from putting more than the one container curbside per

week. (Some drivers may pick up extra, and others will not.) Please remember that when there is a Monday holiday, garbage will be picked up on Wednesday that week. We are in the process of trying to collect back taxes owed to the Town. If you got a letter and you do not owe, please bring proof of payment to the office. If you owe back taxes, please pay before legal action is taken. Thanks.. This is your Town and we need your support.

Thanks to the employees of Onley for the great job(s) they do. If you don't know our employees, stop by the office and meet them - they work for you.

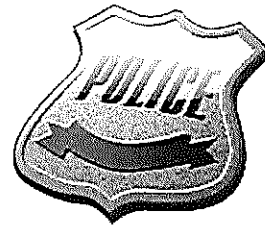


ONLEY POLICE BLOTTER

Greetings from the Onley Police Department. School is back in session so beware of kids and school buses. The holiday season is approaching and everyone needs to take every precaution when out and about during this time-secure your homes and cars and pay attention to your surroundings. Please remember that at our stoplight downtown there is **ONLY ONE LANE OF TRAFFIC IN EACH DIRECTION AND DO NOT TRY TO MAKE IT TWO!** Right turns at a red light are only legal after coming

to a complete STOP and yielding to oncoming traffic. Remember to wear your seatbelts and have your current decals displayed as we are conducting random safety checkpoints in Town. Obey the traffic signs in Town. Please remember that if you need anything, the Police Department is here to help. Please feel free to call on us at anytime.

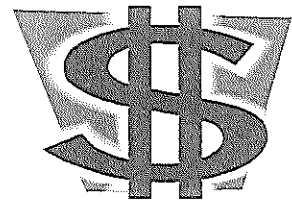
A MESSAGE FROM THE TREASURER
