### CD Maturing at Shore Bank 4/13/2014 (\$59,019.36)

Ms. Salazar presented Council with rates from Shore Bank & Suntrust. She stated that she also contacted PNC Bank & BB&T but neither have responded.

### 2014-2015 Budget Work Session

Ms. Salazar presented Council with a draft 2014-2015 Budget. Council went through the budget line by line and made recommended changes. A copy of the draft budget with changes will be attached to the minutes. Ms. Salazar will make the recommended changes and Council will proceed with budget preparations at the next meeting.

Decal pricing was discussed and Ms. Salazar was asked to find out what the County charges for theirs. Billye D. Custis stated that if the town is not charging the same as the County, the County can come in and collect the difference.

Mr. Gardner asked if Joel will be able to help with sorting the paperwork in the pod. Ms. Salazar stated that the plan is to start scanning and burning to CD the items that have to be saved. Everything else will be documented and destroyed.

Council decided to cancel the cleaning services for the town office.

Ms. Siglin asked if the PD cell phone is being used. Chief Marks stated that it is. Ms. Siglin stated that she has been told to call the ACSO if she needs an officer. Chief Marks explained that it is always better to have the officer dispatched from the ACSO so there is a record of the call. He added that not all of our officers use the cell phone but some do.
