Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pierson at 6:30pm.

Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance

The invocation was given by Dawn Dize and the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by John Dennis.

CD Maturing at Shore Bank 4/17/2015 (\$59,433.15)

Ms. Salazar presented Council with rates from Shore Bank & PNC Bank. She stated that BB&T is not accepting public funds at this time and Suntrust Bank never returned her call.

Motion: To purchase a 15 month CD at Shore Bank in the amount of \$59,433.15 with an interest rate of 1.00% by Dawn Dize and seconded by Ned Finney. Roll Call Vote: Dize-yes; Rillo-absent; Finney-yes; Strautz-yes; Hart-yes; Dennis-yes. MOTION PASSED

2015-2016 Budget Work Session

Mayor Pierson presented Council with a draft 2015-2016 Budget compiled by Ms. Salazar. Council went through the budget line by line and made recommended changes. Chief Spivey presented the Police Department budget. A copy of the draft budget with changes will be attached to the minutes. Ms. Salazar will make the recommended changes and Council will proceed with budget preparations at the next meeting.

Mayor Pierson expressed some concern about Council's unwillingness to give Mr. Pavlik a pay raise at the last meeting. Mr. Finney stated that there was some miscommunication when Mr. Pavlik was hired but he feels it is too soon to discuss a pay raise. He added that he thinks this matter has been resolved for now and will be re-visited in six months.

Billye D. Custis suggested a capital budget for the construction of the new Town Office. Council agreed. Mr. Finney stated that it is his opinion that the garage roof does not need repair at this time.

Ms. Dize asked that Ms. Salazar contact Mr. Simpson and see if he can meet with her about some beautification ideas.

After a short discussion, Council asked to put the purchase of an in-car camera system on the May agenda.
