Call to Order

The Recessed Town Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Pierson at 6:15pm. The invocation was given by Billy Chance. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Mayor Pierson.

Zoning Administrator Vacancy

Mayor Pierson stated that the purpose of this meeting is to talk with Mr. John Pavlik about the zoning administrator vacancy. Mr. Pavlik concluded that he was very involved with building a municipal building at one of his prior positions and feels that he would be very beneficial to the Town with the projected new Town Office.
