

**TOWN OF ONLEY, VIRGINIA
ORDINANCE # 004-20**

**ORDINANCE TO ASSESS A FIVE DOLLAR (\$5.00) E-TICKET FEE FOR THE
IMPLEMENTATION AND MAINTENANCE OF AN ELECTRONIC SUMMONS
SYSTEM FOR THE TOWN**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Onley desires to promote the public health, safety, and welfare of the employees and residents of the Town of Onley; and

WHEREAS, it is declared to be in the public interest to implement an electronic summons system for the health, safety, and welfare, of the Town of Onley Police Department employees; and

WHEREAS, under the authority of §17-279 of the Code of Virginia, the Town of Onley may enact an ordinance to assess a Five Dollar (\$5.00) fee for the implementation and maintenance of an electronic summons system for the Town;

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Onley that the following provisions be enacted.

As set forth in §17-279 of the Code of Virginia, a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) shall be assessed by the Town of Onley, Virginia, in each criminal or traffic case in the General District Court of the County of Accomack, the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court of the County of Accomack, and the Circuit Court of the County of Accomack in which the defendant is charged with a violation of any statute or ordinance. The Assessment shall be collected by the clerk of court in which the action is filed, remitted to the Town Manager or Treasurer for the Town of Onley, and held in a Town of Onley Electronic Summons System Fund (the "ESS Fund") by the Town Manager or Treasurer subject to disbursement by the Town to fund software, hardware, and associated equipment costs for the implementation and maintenance of an electronic summons system. Moneys in the ESS Fund shall be used solely for the purposes of funding software, hardware, and associated equipment costs for the implementation and maintenance of an electronic summons system.

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
