

Zoning Ordinance Section III-4.3 Special Exceptions changed to read as follows:

III-4.3 Special Exceptions

The following uses may be allowed in the Business, General District, B-G, subject to all other requirements of this ordinance, only upon the obtaining of a Special Use Permit from the governing body.

- A. Mobile Food trucks, mobile food and drink units, public billiard parlors and poolrooms, bowling alleys, dance halls, and similar forms of public amusement only after a public hearing shall have been held by the governing body on an application submitted to the body for such use. The governing body may request that the Planning Commission submit a recommendation to them concerning such use applications. In approving any such application, the governing body may establish such special requirements and regulations for the protection of adjacent property, set the hours of operation, and make requirements as they may deem necessary in the public interest.***
- B. Short term rentals are not permitted in any zoning district within the town limits of Onley.***
- C. Any use not specified.***
